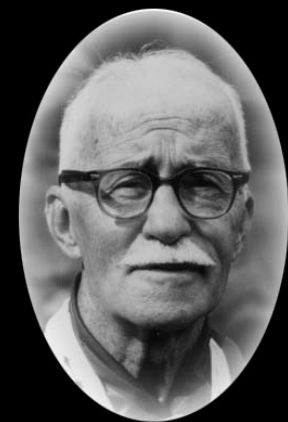

It will also insure that the Order has adequate financial resources to meet its program, service, and leadership development objectives in a quality fashion.
